

# Lillian Stevenson Archives/Museum Report Report 2010-2011

A Christmas gift from Eastern Health, the space we use was needed for other use. This was followed by a letter stating we would have to vacate by the end of February. A meeting of the Alumni Executive, the Archival group, the V.P. of Nursing at Eastern Health and the director of the Centre for Nursing Studies along with the administrative offices of the Miller Center was held in January. Explanation of space needs for the corporation was given, an occurrence which has been common over the years and with which I was familiar.

The rest of the year, and still ongoing, was devoted to sorting, selecting and disposing of some items. A special thank-you goes out to Doreen Bennick who spent hours correcting names and addresses of alumni members. We now have a complete alphabetical class list.

Some museum items were taken by the Provincial Museum. The archival collection was given to the Provincial Archives, and both are in the Rooms. The John Ross Collection and other pertinent items were given to the Medical School Archives. The items on Nurses in WWI were given to the Royal Newfoundland Regiment Museum. The Dr. Cluny Macpherson collection went to the Museum.

The Alumni files are still at the Archives as well as a number and variety of items relating to early nursing practice such as arm baths, basins, utensils and instruments etc. Many pictures will need storage as there is limited hanging space on the walls.
