

The Alumni Organization:

The organization branch of the Alumni was established in 1992 to raise funds for the Diamond Jubilee Scholarship and to help fund the Lillian Stevenson Archives/Museum. All contributions are tax deductible.

Alumni Association:

The Association exists to promote communication among our nursing school graduates. The Diamond Jubilee Scholarship

The General Hospital School of Nursing Alumni Association offers three scholarship annually.

Two scholarships are awarded at the Annual General Meeting to a graduate of the General Hospital School of Nursing. One \$1500 scholarship is offered to a graduate pursuing a Bachelor of Nursing and one \$1500.00 scholarship is offered to a graduate pursuing a Masters of Nursing. Unfortunately, this year there were no applicants so they will not be awarded. If you know of someone who could benefit from this opportunity please encourage them to apply.

The third scholarship offered by the Alumni is \$1000, which is awarded by the ARNNL in November. This scholarship is offered to a child or grandchild of an Alumni member who is currently enrolled and pursuing a career in nursing.
