

The Archives/Museum continues to operate from the 4th floor of the L. A. Miller Centre and is opened every Thursday from 2pm – 4pm except during the Christmas period.

Visitors to the Archives include tourists, year 1 nursing students who visit as part of the introductory nursing course, and former employees of the old General Hospital. The Archive's volunteers will also conduct tours for groups, e.g. class reunions, with advance notice.

This year we lost three former Archives volunteers; Dr. Janet Story (Class 1948), Kathleen Roche (Class 1949) and Marilyn Marsh (Class 1956). Neither had been active in recent years due to health issues however they made a significant contribution to the work of the Archives since it opened in 1981. We owe Miss Story a debt of thanks for preserving our history and making the archives a notable historical site in the province. She is missed.


